Examination of the above-entitled civil actions reveals that 1 2 these actions are related within the meaning of Local Rule 83-123(a) (E.D. Cal. 1997). The actions involve many of the same 3 defendants and are based on the same or similar claims, the same 4 property transaction or event, similar questions of fact and the 5 same questions of law, and would therefore entail a substantial 6 duplication of labor if heard by different judges. Accordingly, 7 the assignment of the matters to the same judge is likely to 8 9 effect a substantial savings of judicial effort and is also 10 likely to be convenient for the parties.

11 The parties should be aware that relating the cases under 12 Local Rule 83-123 merely has the result that both actions are 13 assigned to the same judge; no consolidation of the action is 14 effected. Under the regular practice of this court, related 15 cases are generally assigned to the district judge and magistrate 16 judge to whom the first filed action was assigned.

17 IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the actions denominated CIV-S-05-0211 DFL/GGH, People of the State of California v. United 18 19 States Department of Agriculture and CIV-S-04-2023 LKK/PAN, 20 Sierra Nevada Forest Protection Campaign v. United States Forest 21 Service are reassigned to Judge Morrison C. England, Jr. and Gregory G. Hollows for all further proceedings, and any dates 22 23 currently set in these reassigned cases only are hereby VACATED. 24 The parties are referred to the attached Order Requiring Joint 25 Status Report. Henceforth, the caption on documents filed in the 26 reassigned cases shall be shown as CIV-S-05-0211 MCE/GGH and CIV-27 S-04-2023 MCE/GGH.
